

Activities Completed for Year 2008 – 2009

Three Adopt-a-Highway cleanups – removed a total of 100 bags of trash from roadside and reported to TDOT.

One in-river trash removal – removed over 100 tires and two cubic yards of other waste from river.

One public access and TVA reservation shoreline cleanup – collected 35 bags of trash.

Reported major erosion problem at weir to TVA; problem is now scheduled for repair.

Annual beginners fly tying class, which raised \$1,000 for chapter.

Participated in TU vanity license plate project and had highest percent member participation of all Tennessee chapters.

Helped Coal Creek Watershed Foundation (CCWF) implement and successfully complete a Trout-in-the-Classroom project at Briceville Elementary School.

Helped CCWF successfully complete the annual Kid's Health Day at Briceville Elementary School.

Held fly tying and spin and fly casting lessons and conducted an aquatic invertebrate hunt/class in Clear Creek for the Norris Summer Youth Program.

Held our annual Kids Fish Free Day in June on Norris tailwater.

Provided Back the Brookie educational DVD to the Anderson County High School Advanced Placement Biology class.

Conducted an aquatic ecology field trip for ACHS AP biology class.

Held an aquatic invertebrate survey on Little River for chapter members and their families and friends.

Several members assisted as guides/mentors at Casting for Recovery Weekend at Norton Creek; and we prepared a collection of aquatic invertebrates for women – "Bugs of Norton Creek".
